Nicholas Rice is a 23 year old extreme high-altitude mountaineer based out of Los Angeles, California. He grew up in Hermosa Beach, and has been climbing for thirteen years focusing mainly on alpine and rock. Nick climbed his first 8000 meter peak in 2004, Cho Oyu in Tibet, ranked 6th in the world. He knew the sport was for him when he arrived on the summit just 3 hours after leaving Camp III. Nick has been climbing in Pakistan the past three years with a 2005 expedition to Gasherbrum I and II, a successful solo climb of Gasherbrum II in 2006, an expedition on Broad Peak in 2007 which he led, followed by a solo expedition to Shishapangma in Tibet. He has recently returned from an expedition climbing K2 and Broad Peak this past summer in the Karakorum Range in Northeastern Pakistan.
